 & appoint James Rough my Son Upholster
 Glasgow to be my Sole Executor & universal
 Legatee to whom I leave legate the whole
 goods gear debts Sums of money household
 furniture & in general the whole moveable
 means estate & effects whatsoever that
 may pertain or be owing owing to me at the
 time of my death But always with and
 under the burden of all my just and
 lawful debts deathbed & funeral charges
 & the legacies hereinafter appointed to be
 paid & I ordain my said Executor to pay
 & deliver the following Legacies to the persons
 after named & designed viz^{to} John Christian
 Stewart or Rough my wife all the money
 belonging to me in the National Security
 Savings Bank Glasgow the household
 furniture etc & after her decease - In witness
 whereof I have subscribed this will written
 (in so far as the same is not printed) by
 John Rough Cabinet Maker at Glasgow
 this seventeenth day of June Eighteen hundred
 & sixty three years before three witnesses, to be divided
 equally among my four Sons the business stocks of
 wood tool &c between George & Peter my two Sons
 " (Sgd) John Rough George Waddell. witness John
 " Mular witness. Glasgow 25th Dec 1869 this is the
 last Will & Testament of the late John Rough my
 Father referred to in my Affidavit his date relative to
 the Inventory of his personal Estate (Sgd) James Rough
 Daniel Frazer &c.
